Barr Fellowship Learning Journey to Jordan, October 2023 Program Itinerary

Welcome to your learning journey to Jordan! This itinerary is to be used as a guide for your journey. The times may change throughout, so we encourage everyone to travel with an open mind and flexibility. You will receive updates on timings, reminders on where to be and when throughout the trip both in person and over WhatsApp.

There are two supplementary documents we encourage you to review alongside of your itinerary. Neither of these documents are required readings, rather suggestions to provide context and background on the places you will visit and people you will meet.

1. **Contextual Briefing Guide** — Bios and descriptions of the individuals you will meet and organizations you will visit.
2. **Pre-Trip Resource List** — Articles, novels, films and video clips that provide background on Jordan; the country, politics, social issues, etc. from a variety of perspectives.

Throughout your journey, there will be **Facilitated Reflection Sessions**. We will engage in three kinds of facilitated group reflection during the trip.

- **Morning Gathering:** Center and ground ourselves together with intention
- **Pre-Dinner Pause for Pulse:** A quick go-around check in on the day
- **Evening Circles:** Longer time dedicated to deeper reflection on the full fellowship journey

Enjoy a 2-3 hour walking tour of the city of As Salt, followed by a traditional Jordanian lunch at a local family's home. After lunch, return to Amman to visit the Citadel. From this incredible viewpoint, you will see and learn about both the old and the new Amman.

5:00 PM Return to the hotel to refresh and relax before dinner.

6:00 PM Meet in the hotel lobby for a *Pause for Pulse* before transferring to Books@Cafe for a talk and dinner with Madian Al Jazera for Part 1 of the conversation on LGBTQI issues in Jordan and his work in Jordan and the Middle East.

Environment, Climate Change & Conservation

Feynan Ecolodge - Community Tourism & Sustainability

7:00 AM Have an early breakfast at the Atrium Hotel Restaurant this morning before checking out.

Clothing & Day Pack: *Comfortable walking shoes and clothing. Pack your day pack with anything you would like with you on the bus. You will be in the desert today, so wear clothes, and pack layers, that are comfortable, light weight and that you don't mind getting dusty.*

Important Note: *Please make sure your bags are packed. You will need to bring your large, checked suitcase to reception this morning to store at the Intercontinental. Please make sure you have a luggage lock on this bag. Remember to bring only a carry-on size bag and a backpack for your travels to Dana Reserve, Petra, Wadi Rum and the Dead Sea.*

8:00 AM Depart from the hotel to transfer to Feynan Reception. This is about a 3 hour drive, including rest stops. There will be a *Morning Gathering* during the drive.

Important Note: *Lunch will be late today and there will be plenty of snacks on the bus. You will also be able to purchase extra snacks along the way.*

11:00 AM Arrive to the Feynan Reception area, where you will have a bio break before getting into pick up trucks for a 30 minute drive down a bumpy desert road to the ecolodge.

When you arrive to Feynan Ecolodge, their staff will brief you on the lodge and provide an overview of the schedule of activities. Depending on their occupancy, you will either get your room keys and check in before or after lunch. If after lunch, you can store your bags at reception.

12:15 PM A local guide from the Bedouin community will pick you up from the hotel and walk you to the homes of community members where you will partake in a local cultural activity. Afterwards, your guide will walk you back to the lodge for lunch.

1:30 PM Vegetarian lunch at Feynan Ecolodge.

3:00 PM Gather at the lodge's reception for a *90-minute Circle* to reflect on your Barr Fellowship experience. **Bring your journals and pens!**

4:45 PM Regroup in the lodge's reception area where a local guide will meet you to set out for a sunset walk.

7:00 PM Vegetarian dinner at Feynan Ecolodge.

9:00 PM The lodge hosts star gazing on the roof every evening at 9:00 PM.

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**Friday
October 20**

Petra

7:00 AM Start your day with coffee or tea at the lodge's restaurant where you will collect a boxed breakfast to bring on the road.

Clothing & Day Pack: *Comfortable walking shoes and clothing. There will be a lot of walking today. Pack your water bottle, sunscreen, a camera and sunglasses or a hat.*

7:30 AM You will be picked up from the entrance of the lodge to drive back to Feynan's Reception Area; a 30 minute drive down the bumpy desert road in pick-up trucks.

8:15 AM Board the bus to drive to Petra, with a *Morning Gathering* and rest stops along the way.

11:00 AM Arrive to the Visitor Center at Petra where you will check in and meet your guide and evening guest speaker, Dr. Sami al-Hasanat.

11:30 AM Start your walking tour through the ancient city of Petra. Be mindful of the crowds and sellers in Petra. Along the tour, you will stop for lunch at Basin Restaurant.

2:30 PM Arrive to the Roman Bathhouse where you will meet with SELA's leadership team to learn about their programs in training, preservation & conservation. You will sit in the Bedouin tent they have set up at the archaeological site for their presentation.

After the visit, you will take a shuttle bus from the Roman Bathhouse back to the Visitors Center to board your bus and transfer to the Marriott.

5:00 PM Check in and settle into your rooms before tonight's talk with Dr. Sami.

6:00 PM Gather in the lobby to walk to the hotel's Bedouin Tent for a conversation with Dr. Sami on his area of expertise - tourism, politics and social change in the Petra Region of Jordan.

8:30 AM Start your day with breakfast at your leisure, available from 7:00 AM.

Clothing: *Comfortable walking shoes and clothing. Layers for this evening in the desert. Pack a day pack with anything you would like with you on the bus.*

9:30 AM Gather in the lobby, with your bags before checking out.

10:00 AM Depart from the hotel to transfer to Wadi Rum, about a 2 hour drive.

Wadi Rum

12:00 PM Check in to the Visitors Center at Wadi Rum before driving to Suncity Camp.

12:30 PM Arrive to Suncity Camp, where you will be met by porters who will collect your bags. You will have lunch when you arrive and check in to your rooms after.

2:00 PM Meet in the main area of the Camp to hop in jeeps and depart for an afternoon desert jeep tour. The exact time of the tour will vary depending on what you are seeing and how the day pans out. After the tour, you will return to the Camp from anywhere between 4:00 and 5:30 PM.

6:00 PM Gather in the main area of the Camp for a *one-hour Circle* to reflect on the Learning Journey to Jordan. [Bring your journals and pens!](#)

7:00 PM The Camp's delicious buffet dinner is served from 7:00 PM.

After dinner, you will have the option to do a stargazing activity in the evening, which can be arranged through another, nearby camp.

Overnight: Suncity Camp

Wadi Rum

7:30 AM Start your day with breakfast at your leisure, available from 7:00 AM.

Clothing & Day Pack: *Comfortable walking shoes and clothing. Layers for this evening in the desert. Pack sunscreen, sunglasses or a hat, a water bottle and a camera.*

8:30 AM Gather as a group for a *Morning Gathering* before setting out for today's adventure. Come prepared with comfortable sneakers or hiking boots for today's desert hike.

9:00 AM Today will be a full-day jeep tour of Wadi Rum including a hike of Jabal Al-Hash (about a 3 hour hike), a desert lunch, and an optional camel ride on the way back to the Camp. Please inform your Guide, Nader, know in advance if you would like to do this camel ride as this has to be booked in advance.

Important Note: *Local communities in Wadi Rum have a huge respect for camels. In these communities, the camels are well taken care of and are important for the local economy.*

4:00 - 6:00 PM Return to the camp to have the afternoon at your leisure. The jeep tour is flexible and can be between 2 - 4 hours, depending on the group and your surroundings.

7:00 PM Enjoy your last evening in Wadi Rum with Suncity's buffet dinner.

**Monday
October 23**

Travel to the Dead Sea

7:00 AM Start your day with breakfast at your leisure, available from 7:00 AM. Afterwards, collect your bags and check out from the Camp.

Clothing & Day Pack: *We recommend you pack a swimsuit, water shoes, sunscreen and anything you may want to swim in the Dead Sea in a day pack so that it is easily accessible when you arrive to the hotel. This includes a swimsuit, water shoes, sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses and loungewear or a beach cover up.*

8:00 AM Gather as a group to board the vehicle and set off for the Dead Sea. It is about a 4 hour drive, and along the way, you will have a *Morning Gathering* and rest stops.

12:00 PM Arrive to the hotel and store your luggage at reception while you walk over to Il Terrazzo, the hotel's Italian Restaurant, for lunch. After lunch, you will check in to your rooms.

Note on Spa Treatments: *If you would like a spa treatment (spa menu attached), we recommend booking this in advance. Please let Dana know by Tuesday, October 22 what spa treatment you would like and what time you would like to schedule it. If Dana is not able to book this the day before, we suggest booking this as soon as you arrive at the hotel.*

4:00 PM Gather in the lobby to walk down to the Dead Sea together for a dip in the salty water and maybe even cover yourself in the healing Dead Sea mud!

7:10 AM Gather in the lobby to check out and board the vehicles. Those of you returning to Boston (flight details below) will board the bus and those of you crossing the border to Israel this morning will board a separate vehicle.

Notes for those of you who are traveling to Israel via the Allenby Crossing:

- **7:20 AM** You will be picked up from the Intercontinental Amman and transferred to the Jordanian Terminal at the Allenby Border Point / King Hussein Bridge.
- Your driver will drop you off just outside of the border crossing terminal.
- From there, you will need to walk to the VIP Booking Office to book and pay for the VIP service about \$115 USD to be paid in cash. Please note that this cost is subject to change.

Important Note: This is not the same building as the Immigration & Customs Building. It is closer to the entrance where your driver will drop you off. Please be sure to ask for the VIP Service when you arrive so that you go to the right building.

- The Jordanian VIP staff will:
 - Collect your Jordanian Exit Tax which is 10 Jordanian Dinar (JOD). This must be paid in cash with local currency.
 - Walk you through security to have your luggage scanned.

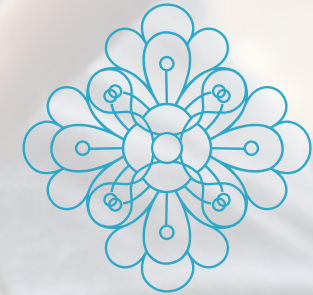
AGE RESTRICTIONS

Only facial treatments are available for pregnant women.

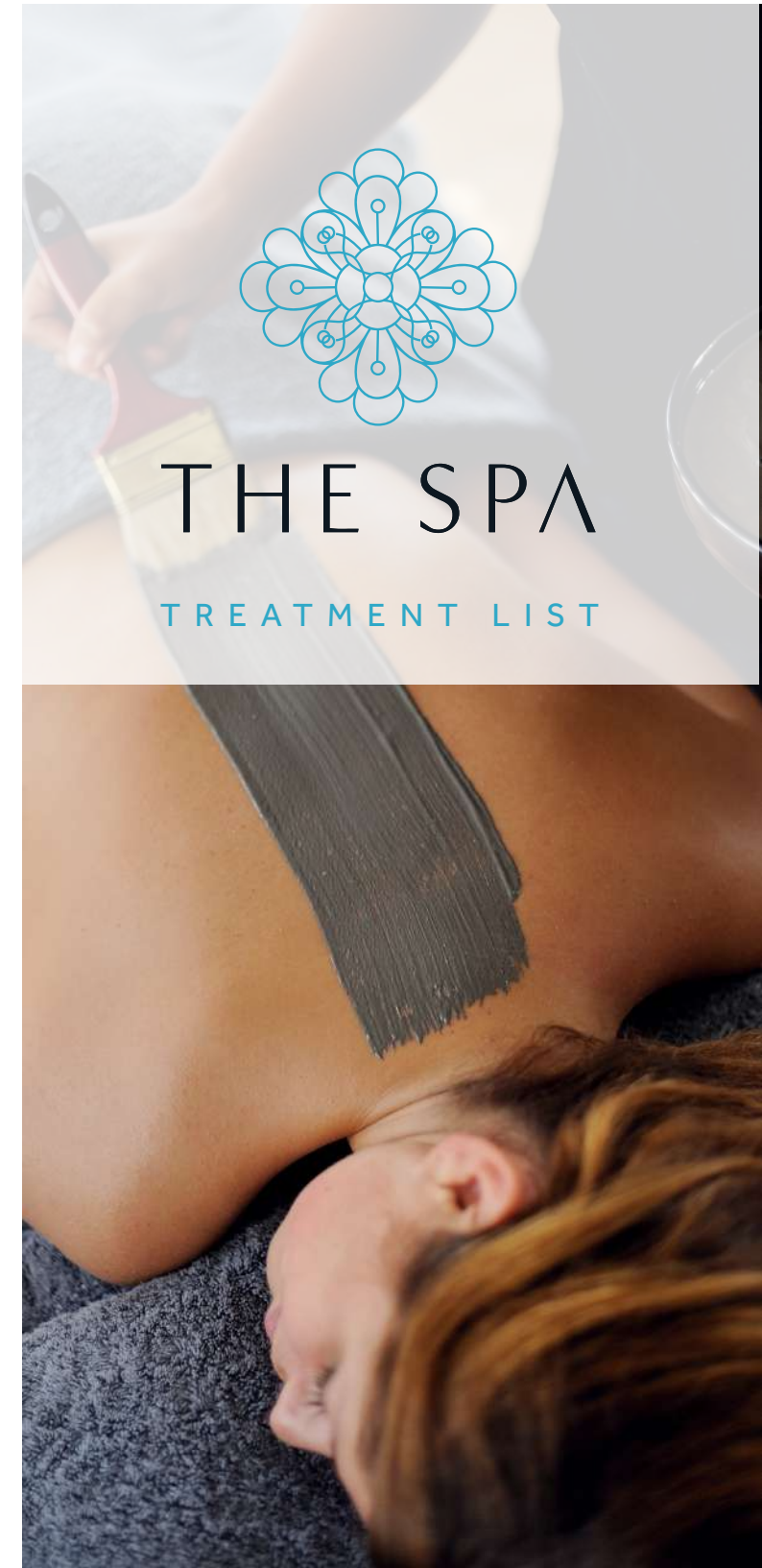
