
Arrival or Transfer to Extension

International or domestic flights: Pending

If you are flying into Entebbe, a representative will greet you at your gate to guide you through customs and immigration (if applicable) and assist with your luggage. You'll be connected with your private driver and driven to your hotel to check in and rest after your travels.

This evening, take a few moments to stop by the concierge and let them know of tomorrow's early morning departure so that breakfast can be arranged in accordance with your departure. You can schedule this to be a to-go style breakfast if you'd prefer, just note that no liquids can be taken with you.

Day Two

Travel to Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge

6:15 AM: Have an early breakfast before meeting your driver to depart to Kasese Airstrip for your scheduled flight.

Regional flight: Pending

Please note that there is a baggage restriction of 15kgs per person maximum, including carry-on luggage. All baggage must be in soft-sided bags.

Upon arrival, you'll be greeted by a representative from the Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge who will assist with your transfer to your accommodation (~2-hour drive). Soak in the exceptional views as you drive through the southern sector of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park.

After checking in, enjoy lunch on-site before visiting the Batwa Community later this afternoon. The Batwa were the first inhabitants of the forest, and during this experience, you'll learn about their history and traditions that have been cultivated over thousands of years.

Later, return to your lodge to relax and have dinner.


Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge

At over 6,560 feet above sea level, Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge is Uganda's highest lodge. Guests at Clouds stay in private cottages constructed from local volcanic stone. Every cabin has a generous sitting room with a fireplace, large armchairs, and handwoven carpets.





The main lodge features soaring ceilings with exposed wooden beams and endless views of treetops, volcanoes, and mountains.



Day Three

Gorilla Tracking in the Nkuringo Area


7:00 AM: After an early breakfast, you'll set off to the Nkuringo area to begin gorilla tracking while following closely behind your professional guides. The Nkuringo gorilla family was named after the rolling hills where they were first sighted, and the area is one of four gorilla trekking sectors in Bwindi Impenetrable National Park.

Sit in the forest among the gorillas, listen to them "talk" to one another, and marvel at the sheer size of the dominant male — the silverback. It is extraordinary to sit in the dense rainforest, knowing you are with some of the few remaining mountain gorillas in the world! It is good to be prepared for varied terrain as the landscape of this area has a variety of deep and thick brush.

Everyone must wear a mask during tracking. Please be sure that you pack one to bring with you during this experience.

Following a full-day trek, return to your lodge to rest up and share stories of an exceptional day over dinner.

Day Four

Gorilla Habituation Experience

Today, you'll have the beautiful opportunity to follow along with the team that is currently working with a gorilla community that is undergoing habituation. This gorilla experience takes place among a rugged landscape of dense jungle, cascading waterfalls, sparkling mountain streams, deep valleys, and steep ridges.

6:30 AM: Wake up early for a hearty breakfast to give you the energy for the exciting day ahead. This trek can take anywhere from 30 minutes to six hours, and a reasonable degree of fitness and a sturdy pair of walking shoes are required. Gloves to protect your hands and long pants are also essential.

Because the group under habituation is always monitored, the habituation team will know where the gorillas are at all times. Due to that ability, this experience will be no more strenuous than the normal tracking activity, and you're able to stop to rest at any time.

Porters can help with carrying luggage, snacks, cameras, and any other heavy gear you wish to bring along, allowing you to focus on the trail without having to worry about your things. Additionally, they can provide physical support to maintain balance and prevent fatigue during your trek.

After this incredible and intimate experience among the gorillas, return to your accommodation for a relaxing evening and share the day's stories.





Day One

Arrival or Transfer to Extension

Have an early morning breakfast and transfer to Entebbe International Airport for your scheduled flight to Kasese.

Flight time: 07h00/10h00.

Upon arrival at the airstrip, meet with the lodge representative to transfer for one hour. On the way, you will visit the Rwenzori Founders Gallery Bronze, which offers a wonderful insight into the creation of some of the most gorgeous bronzes. You will also visit the Rubona Women's Basket Cooperative.

In the National Park, transfer to River Station private boat access to reach the lodge.


Honey Bear Bush Camp

Honeybear Bush Camp is situated on the south bank of the Kazinga Channel, in Kyambura Game Reserve, part of the Queen Elizabeth National Park. An intimate, classic safari experience is guaranteed as Honeybear is the only camp in the entire reserve.





The camp is home to five beautifully appointed, double, en-suite safari tents equipped with outdoor bucket showers. Each tent is set up to enjoy views of the Kazinga channel and the Rwenzori Mountains. You will fall asleep to the grunts of hippos and wake up to herds of elephants coming down to have their daily drink.



Day Two

Chimpanzee Tracking and Dhow Trip

Enjoy an early morning cup of tea, then transfer to Kyambura Gorge (transfer time: 1 hour) for your morning chimpanzee tracking.

You will return to the lodge for lunch and some time at leisure, and later enjoy a shared dhow trip on the Kazinga Channel among hippos swimming elephants, and sundowners.

Day Three


Lion Tracking and Afternoon to Explore

This morning, transfer to the starting point for lion tracking.

This is a guided game drive with the researchers. It involves taking a closer look at the lions and learning more about their behavior.

Return to the lodge for lunch and relaxation. You may also opt to visit Crater Lake or take a guided nature walk around the lodge.

Day Four

Return to Entebbe

Following an early breakfast, transfer to Kasese airstrip (transfer time: -/+ 1 hour) for your scheduled flight to Entebbe International Airport.

Flight time: 10h15/11h25

Note that the scheduled flight makes two stops at different airstrips before arriving at Entebbe Airport. Stay at the airport to connect to your outbound flight.



Papa's Camp



Game Drives, Boat Tour, and Hike

Embark on early morning game drives through the park in search of wildlife with the chance of spotting the lions, elephants, and many other species.

Enjoy a private boat trip on the Nile and a hike to the top of the falls.
