Experience an unforgettable extension to Western Uganda with a stay at the breathtaking Kyaninga Lodge, perched on a crater lake with sweeping views of the Rwenzori Mountains. More than a comfortable retreat, Kyaninga Lodge exemplifies sustainable hospitality by channeling its proceeds to support children with disabilities through the Kyaninga School.

Your adventure begins with an early flight to Kasese airport, followed by a guided game drive through Queen Elizabeth National Park, a scenic lunch, and a boat cruise along the wildlife-rich Kazinga Channel. We'll spend a day exploring maternal health initiatives through one of Together Women Rise's grantees, Babies and Mothers Alive, and also visit the Kyaninga School to see firsthand how the lodge's proceeds are making a meaningful impact in the lives of children with disabilities.

Domestic flights: Pending

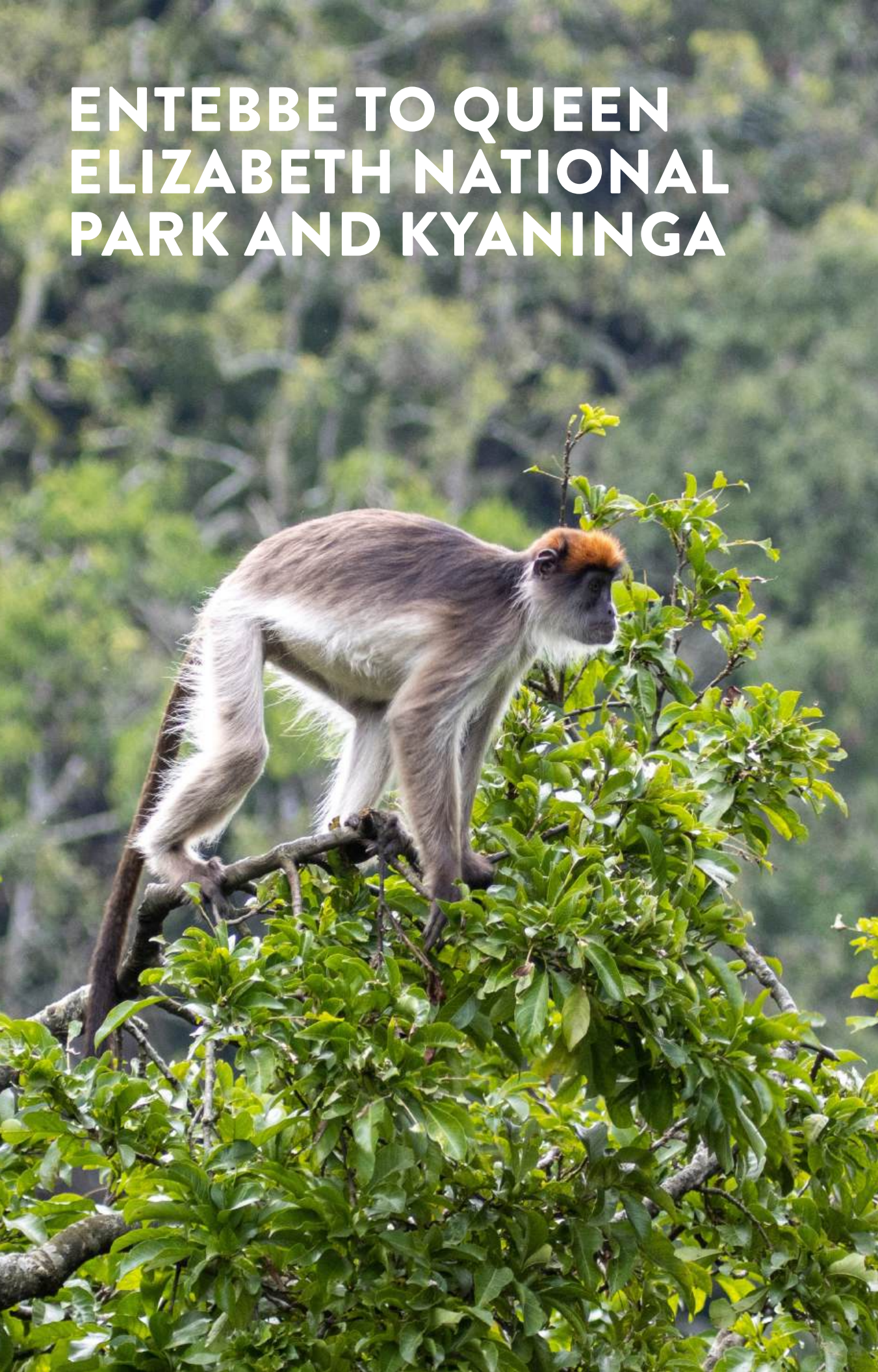
Enjoy a game drive and picnic lunch in Queen Elizabeth National Park.

Kyanninga Inclusive Model School Visit, Lodge Activities, and Relaxation

After breakfast, visit Kyanninga Inclusive Model School and enjoy a visit to experience inclusive education in action and hear about the program's work with 18 community schools.

Kyanninga Inclusive Model School (KIMS) is a pioneering primary school that delivers high-quality, inclusive education to children with disabilities and their typically developing peers. Situated within the Kyanninga Education Hub, it offers a dual Uganda-UK curriculum in small, mixed-age classes alongside a special support center.

Afterwards, return to the lodge and enjoy time to unwind, relax or explore the beautiful surroundings at your leisure.

The lodge offers a variety of optional activities, free of charge activities including: Crater Rim Walk, Forest Walk, or Lake Kyanninga Walk. At the lake, kayaks and paddleboards are available on request.

Visit Babies and Mothers Alive

Today, you will visit another Together Women Rise grantee and get a deeper understanding of maternal health in rural Uganda.

Babies and Mothers Alive

Babies and Mothers Alive is a grantee of Together Women Rise and is transforming maternal/newborn health in rural Uganda through community engagement, tech-enabled transport, clinical improvement, and sustainable local leadership.

Rise's grant funded the Mama Rescue Project, which provides transportation for laboring women to access health facilities and emergency obstetric care—reducing major obstetric complications and maternal and newborn deaths.

You will meet local health workers and some of the patients who have benefited from this program.

What's Included

Inclusions:

- All meals as specified in the itinerary.
- At Kyaninga Lodge, drinks included with meals are coffee, water, and tea. Additional drinks are paid by consumption.

- Round-trip domestic flights (Entebbe-Kasese).
- All transfers between airstrips and lodges.
- Activities as stipulated in the itinerary.
- Park, guide, and conservation fees.
- Emergency evacuation insurance.
- Drivers, guides gratuities included.

Exclusions:

- Passport and visa fees.
